The standards used in accreditation procedures are organised into <u>six themes</u>:

- 1. Aims and objectives
- 2. Curriculum
- 3. Staff
- 4. Facilities
- 5. Internal quality assurance
- 6. Conditions for continuity

### **NVAO & EFQM**

**NVAO** has developed a system for quality assurance that:

- allows an integrated approach of the organisation and its working processes by applying the nine criteria of the EFQM-model,
- allows frequent evaluation of the results and a structured plan for improvement (by following the Plan-Do-Check-Act cycle),
- is transparent, simple and non-bureaucratic through the application of a limited number of instruments),
- provides the basis for an external (international) evaluation by the adoption of international standards in the development of the internal quality assurance system,
- stimulates involvement of all staff members, and in addition,
- guarantees involvement of all stakeholders by means of an open dialogue with these stakeholders.

### **Quality definitions**

- The degree to which a set of inherent characteristics fulfils requirements (ISO)
- Quality is meeting customer expectations
- All those planned and systemic actions required to provide adequate confidence that a product or service will satisfy given requirements
- Quality is neither mind nor matter, but a third entity independent of the two, even though Quality cannot be defined, you know what it is (Pirsig)

- **II. Product quality level**
- **III.** Quality process
- IV. Work Instructions
- v. Quality procedures
- vi. Quality policy



### **Quality jargon**

- Inspection
  - Activities such as measuring, examining, testing, gauging one or more characteristics of a product or service and comparing these with specified requirements to determine conformity
- Control
  - That part of quality management focused on fulfilling quality requirements (ISO)
- Assurance
  - That part of quality management focused on providing confidence that quality requirements are fulfilled (ISO)
- Improvement
- Indicators
- System
- Management
